This has been a busy year for our fire district with response to 5,896 calls for service. As an all-hazards agency these emergencies included fire, medical emergencies, motor vehicle crashes, natural and man-made events, hazardous materials incidents, technical rescues, brush fires and many other types of incidents.

As always charitable giving and community involvement were a big part of the year. In 2024, we attended countless community events including WGCU's Be My Neighbor Day, GCTC's Trick-or-Treat night, and Athenian Academy's Fall Fest.
